I found a free service I'd like you to consider using to help us communicate better with each other throughout the year. It was created by a mom of a child with diabetes.

BlueLoop is online and allows all caregivers - parents, nurses, teachers, etc. - to put information like BGs, inhaler use, other tests, and notes into my child's account and instantly send a text and/or email notification so that we are all in the loop and know how he's doing without making phone calls or sending hand-written notes. It's also a great way for you to send me information, like when you're low on supplies or need more snacks.

If you are not already registered with BlueLoop, here's what you need to do. It's FREE, btw!:

1. Go to blueloop.mycareconnect.com/school.
2. Complete the online form.
3. Log in and on the My Profile tab, click the "My Schools" button on the left side.
4. Next to the name of his school, click the Print or Send Code / Info to Parent to give me your unique verification code.
5. I'll then put your code in my child's account and we'll be connected so that when you log into your BlueLoop account, you'll see his name and can enter his info as described above.
